Popular interest in body image issues has grown dramatically in recent years, due to an emphasis on individual responsibility and self-determination in contemporary society as well as the seemingly limitless capacities of modern medicine; however body image as a separate field of academic inquiry is still relatively young. The contributors of *Body Image and Identity in Contemporary Societies* explore the complex social, political and aesthetic interconnections between body image

and identity.
